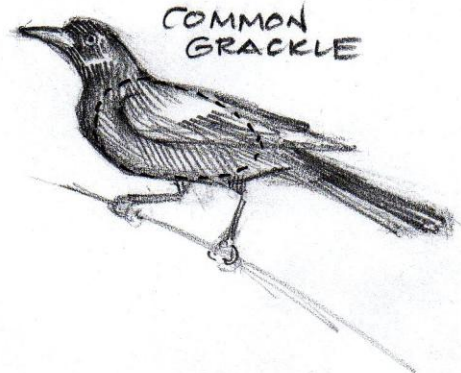

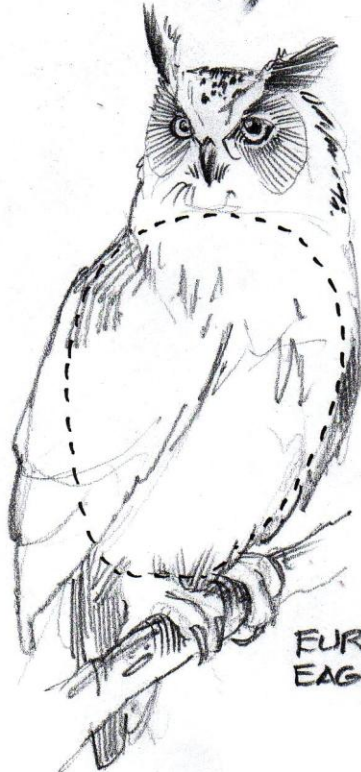
LAUGHING GULL
